

Kingdom Fungi

The fungal kingdom consists of about eight groups (phyla): Microsporidia, Blastocladiomycota, Neocallimastigomycota, Chytridiomycota, Glomeromycota, Zygomycota, Ascomycota and Basidiomycota of which the Zygomycota is a mishmash of not necessarily closely related groups. Only the Asco- and Basidiomycota form fruitbodies and these are also by far the largest groups of fungi.
